ONE SUBJECT

Each Level 3 subject here at Doncaster College is equivalent to three A-Levels, so when you apply to study with us at this level you only need one subject.

Within that subject you will gain the UCAS points needed to progress to university, so unlike other colleges where you perhaps study three A-Levels to gain the right UCAS points, here you only need one.

If you do not have the GCSE grades to progress to a level 3 qualification you will be able to re-sit your English and maths here as well, combine that with a level 2 qualification of your choice to enable you to step up to a level 3 the following year.

ENGLISH & MATHS

English and maths are an essential part of your studies here at Doncaster College and can sometimes be a real barrier for the future if you do not have a pass.

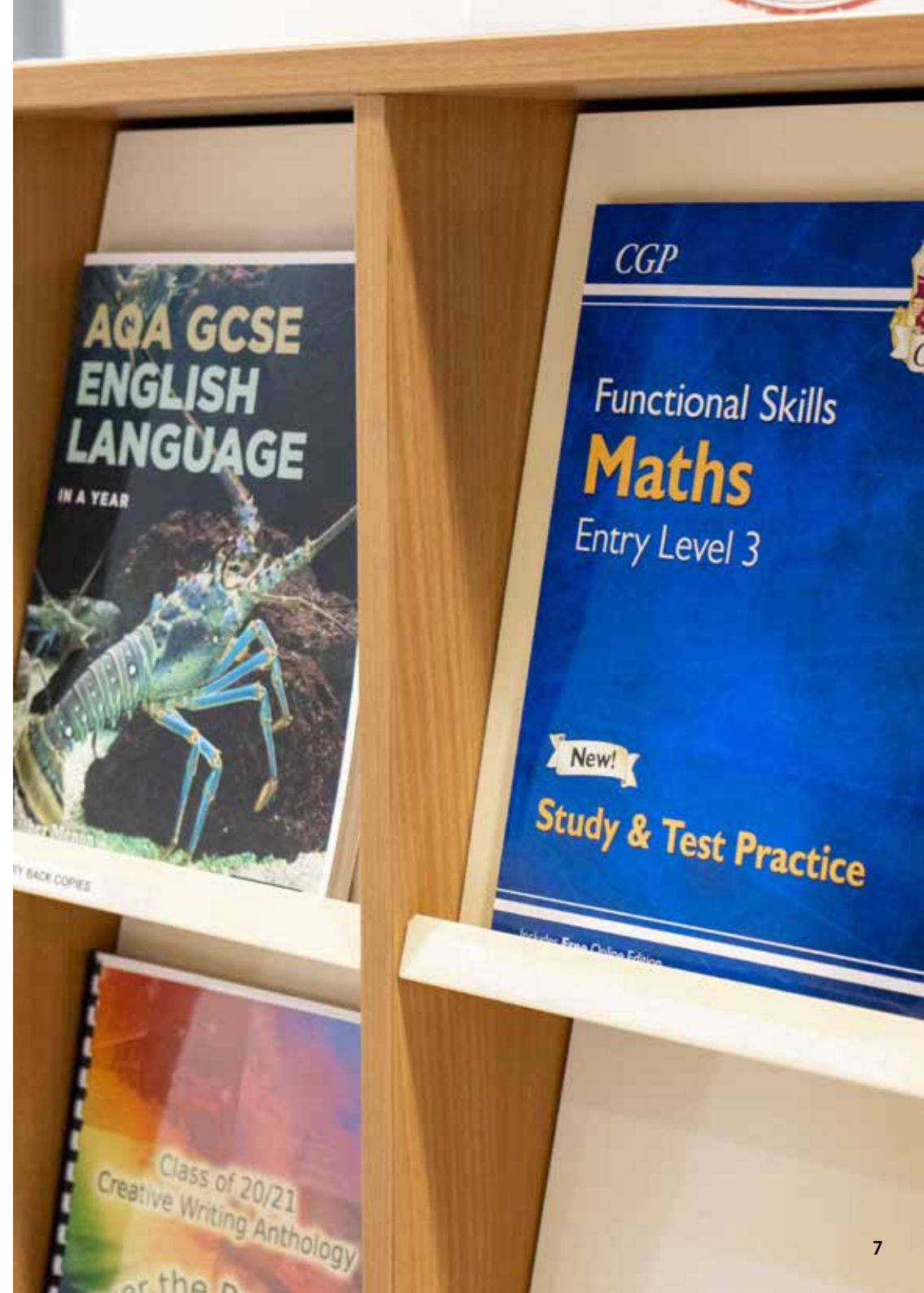
Employers and universities really value these essential qualifications, so it is important we help you achieve them. If you do not have a pass in either or both subjects, then do not worry!

As an important part of your programme of study you will work towards achieving a 9-4 (A*-C) with the help of our specialist tutors, alongside studying your chosen subject with us. If you have a grade 3 or 2 (D or E) in either or both subjects, you will be enrolled onto our GCSE programme. If this is not the case, you may be enrolled onto a more suitable Functional Skills

Programme, which will still teach you the same skills needed for everyday life, studies and employment.

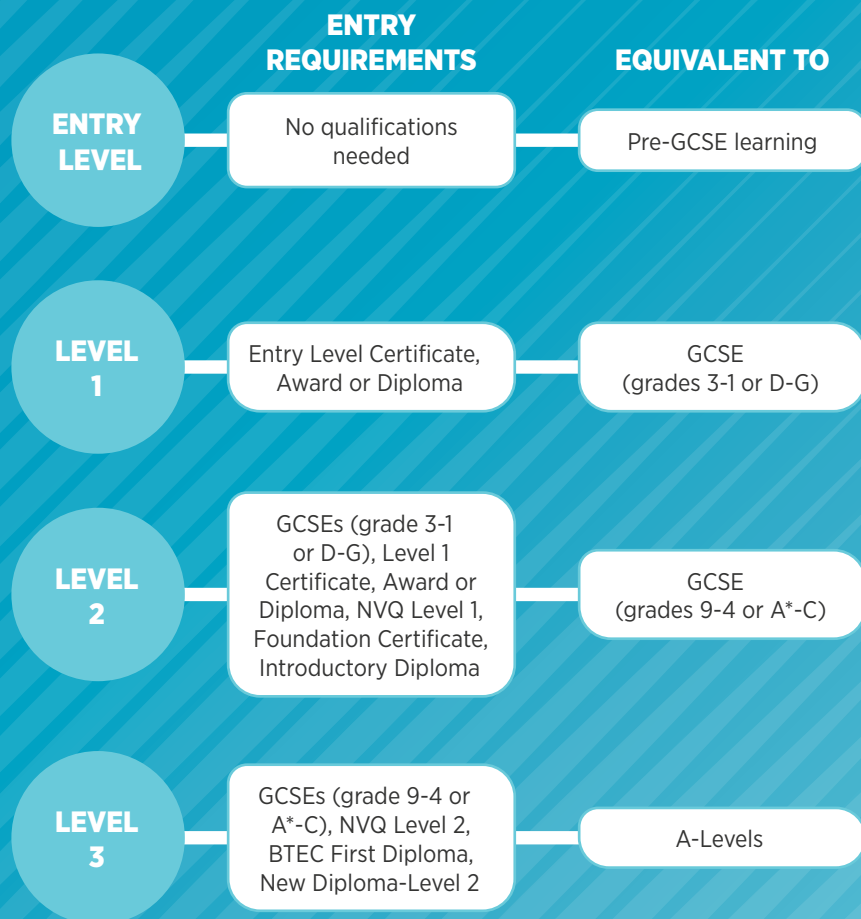
WHY STUDY ENGLISH & MATHS?

- These skills can help you understand your finances, communication, and help you gain a better understanding of current issues including politics and current affairs.
- Most universities look for at least a grade 4 (C) in GCSE English and maths.
- Increase your potential earnings.
- People with good GCSE grades in English and maths also earn approximately £2,000 more than those who do not.

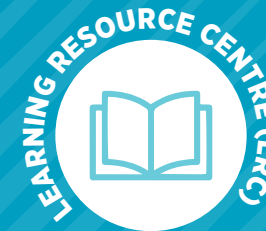
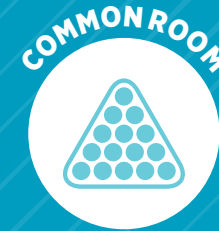

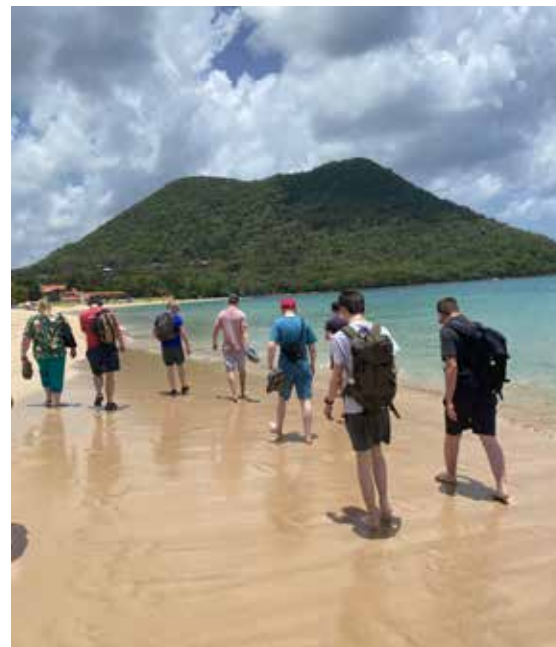
THE TURING SCHEME

ACADEMY OF SPORT

Enhance your academic journey with our Sports Academy at Doncaster College.

Led by pros and qualified coaches, the aim of our academy is to provide you with the developmental guidance to enhance your current skills and sporting capabilities whilst gaining an academic or vocational qualification at Doncaster College.

Focusing on football or rugby (union) all of our student players receive quality coaching throughout the week and compete in the Association of Colleges (AoC) leagues throughout their academic journeys, students from all curriculum areas of the College are welcome to come down and play.

For those students wishing to continue their studies with University Campus Doncaster, progression routes are available into our 18+ Academy squads competing in the British Universities & Colleges Sport (BUCS) leagues.

FOOTBALL ACADEMY

Redeveloped in 2022, our Football Academy has gone from strength to strength over the last few seasons under the guidance of new coaching staff.

Consisting of a competitive AoC men's team (16-18), a competitive AoC women's (16-18) team, and a participation team for both men and women (16+), the ethos of the football academy is to not only develop technical players on the

pitch, but grow mentally strong and confident young adults off the pitch.

- Regular competitive fixtures against other colleges in our region and further afield

- Expert staff with experience within elite football and sport
- Nutritional advice and support through TASS
- Opportunities to coach and referee
- Varsity events at the Eco-Power Stadium, home to Doncaster Rovers FC



RUGBY ACADEMY

Our Rugby Academy is delivered in partnership with local RFU Championship Club Doncaster Knights. With aspirations for continued promotion within the AOC and BUCS leagues, the Knights Academy is led by an expert team full of professional playing experience, including Doncaster Knights newly appointed First Team Assistant Coach and Head of Academy Tyson Lewis and Director of Rugby Development and Pathways Glen Kenworthy.

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) is a real highlight that all of our students can get involved with. The DofE offers invaluable experiences from volunteering, life skills, activities, community projects, and expeditions.

When you take part in the DofE we will provide you with an opportunity to learn new skills, tackle challenges, and gain confidence. You will learn skills such as being able to handle tough situations, problem solving, working well with others, and improving your communication skills; all things that will make your CV stand out and impress universities and future bosses, as employers really value the skills that people with the award bring to the table.

In 2022/23, we had the most students ever completing the full DofE Award across the DN Colleges Group, with 200 students taking part. In the past, Foundation Studies students have taken part in an expedition to Peat Rigg in North Yorkshire, thanks to funding from the DofE.

APPRENTICESHIPS

WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

An apprenticeship offers you the chance to study and work at the same time. This allows you to earn a wage whilst gaining qualifications and valuable industry experience.

Unlike most traditional full-time courses, apprenticeships with DN Colleges Group offer 'roll-on roll-off' programmes, which means there are opportunities to enrol at various points throughout the year, not just at the beginning of an academic year. This means we have vacancies available throughout the year for new apprentices to start.

- When you leave school

- Whilst on your apprenticeship, you will be an employee of a company and entitled to the same benefits as other staff, including holidays.

T Levels are two-year courses that have been developed in close collaboration with employers and businesses, ensuring that the curriculum aligns with industry requirements and equips you with the necessary skills for the workforce.

During your T Level journey, you will experience a combination of classroom learning and practical, hands-on experience through an industry placement lasting approximately 315 hours (or around 45 days). This placement will provide you with valuable insights and real-world exposure to complement your theoretical knowledge.

Completing a T Level will equip you with the knowledge, skills, and experience needed to access skilled employment opportunities, pursue further studies, or even opt for a higher apprenticeship. It's worth noting that T Levels are equivalent to three A-Levels.

The structure of a T Level typically includes the following elements:

- A technical qualification, which focuses on developing specialised skills and knowledge for a specific occupation or career path.
- Emphasis on digital skills development, recognising the increasing importance of technology in today's job market.
- An industry placement, where you will have the opportunity to work with an employer, gaining practical experience and exposure to a real work environment.
- The requirement to meet a minimum standard in maths and English, if you haven't already achieved it, to ensure a well-rounded education.
- Approximately 80% of your time will be spent in the classroom, while the remaining 20% will be dedicated to your industry placement, striking a balance between theoretical and practical learning.

INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS

Each T Level programme ensures the inclusion of an industry placement where you can collaborate with an employer to enhance your practical and technical skills relevant to your chosen occupation. These placements have a minimum duration of 315 hours (approximately 45 days), although they may extend beyond that.

Employers have the flexibility to provide industry placements as a continuous block, on specific days, or to combine both approaches.

Furthermore, employers can explore the possibility of sharing part of the placement with another employer if required.

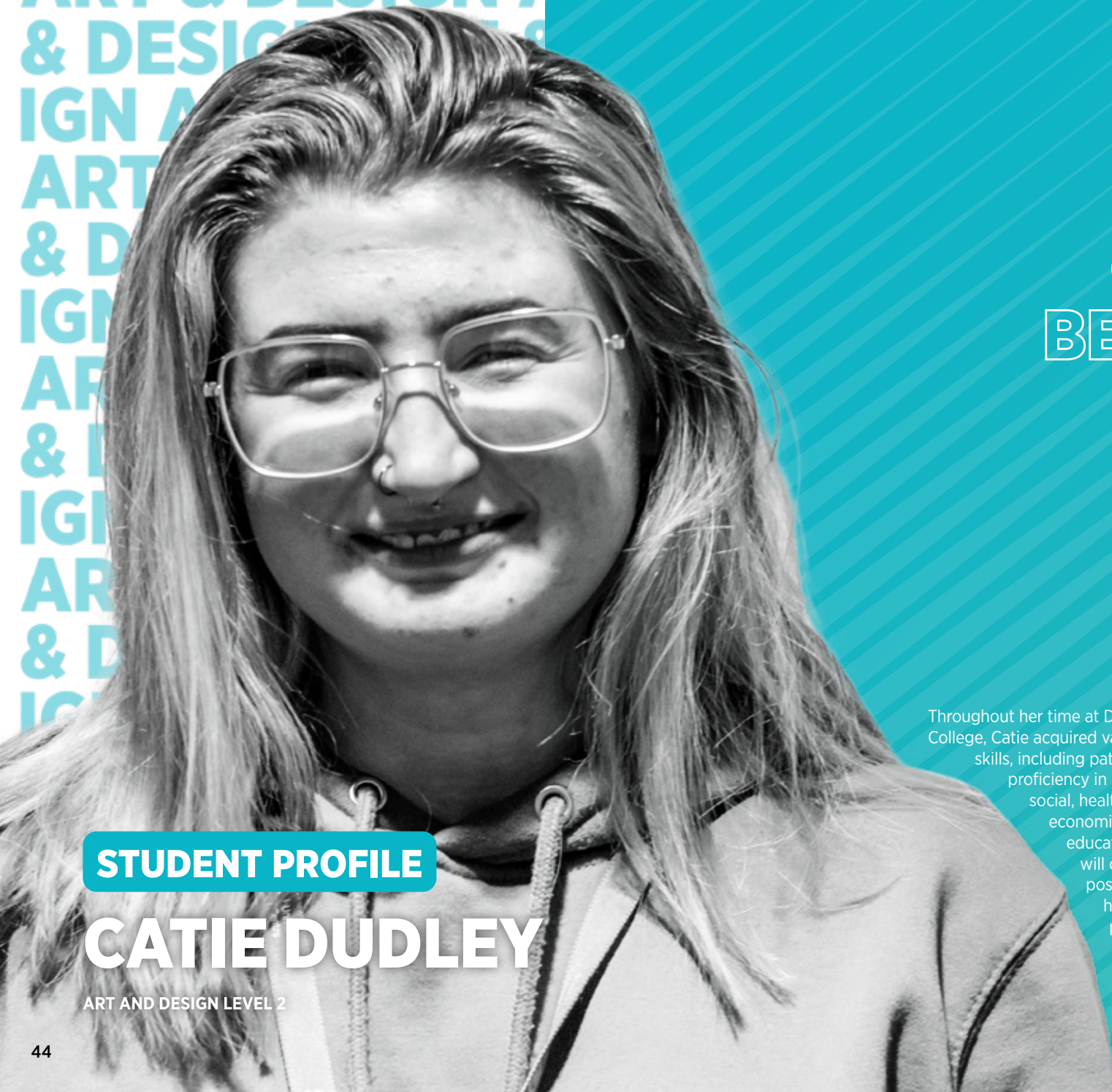

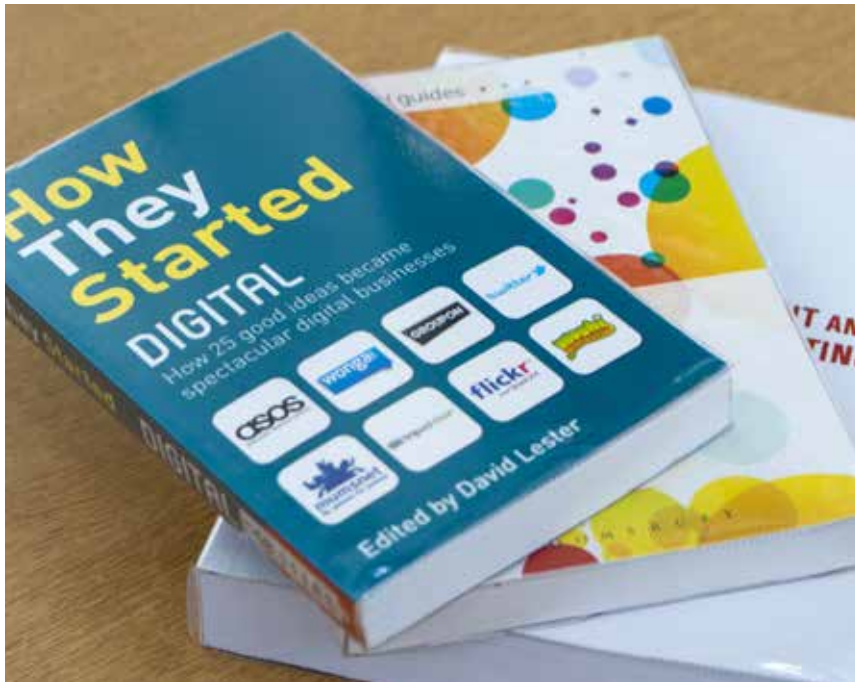

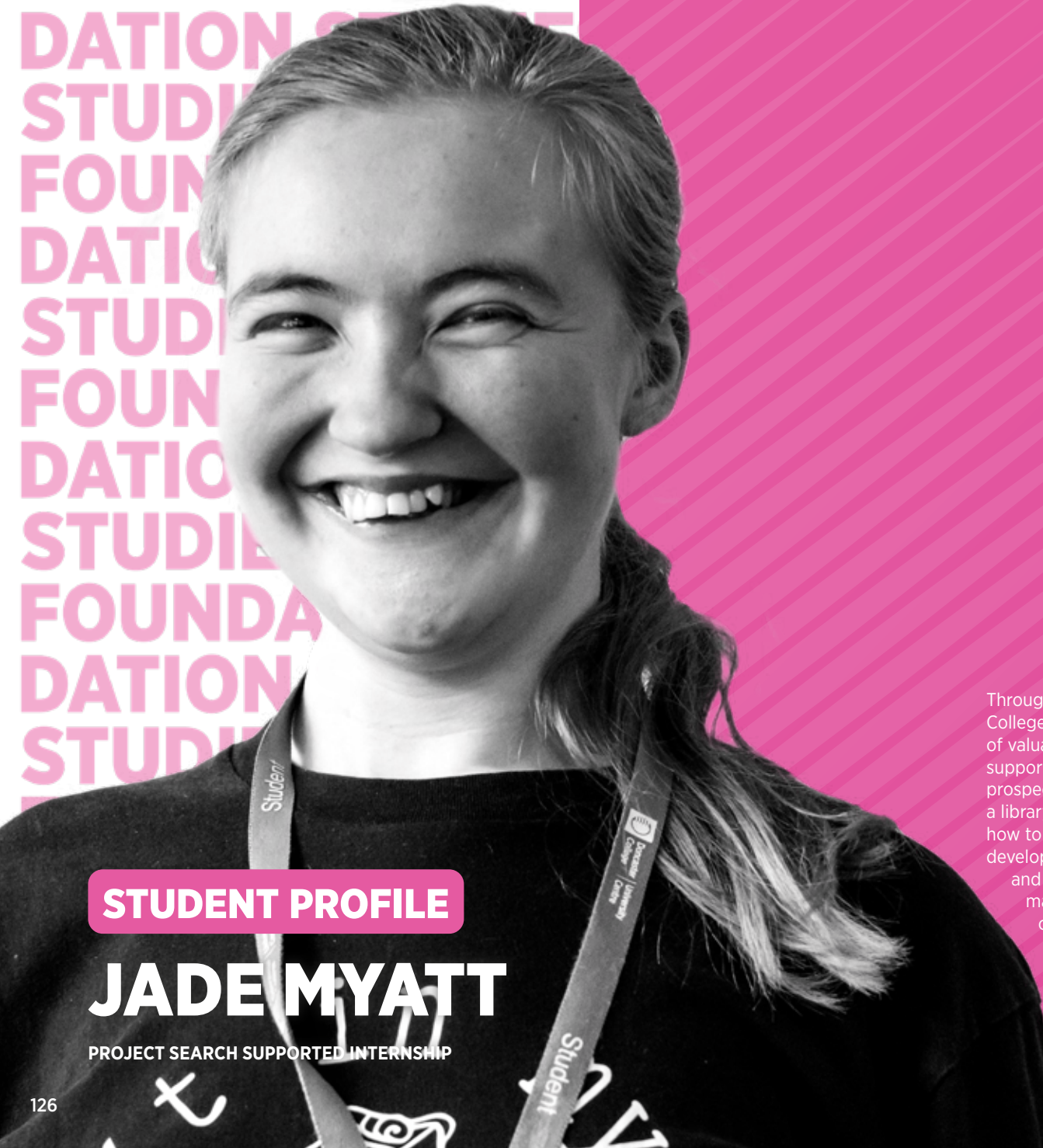

Access programmes are developed to enable 'adult returnees' to build upon their past work and life experiences to increase their self-confidence, self-belief, academic, and personal skills.

If you are not ready to go directly onto Access, we offer the following courses in preparation for Access; GCSE English, GCSE Maths, GCSE Biology, GCSE Chemistry, and Level 2 Access (Progression to Further Studies in Health Sciences).

***Please Note:** Course fees for Level 3 Access to HE apply. Students under 24 who do not already hold a level 3 qualification (e.g. A-Levels or Level 3 BTEC) do not have to pay fees. All other students can apply for the Advanced Learner Loan to cover the fees.*

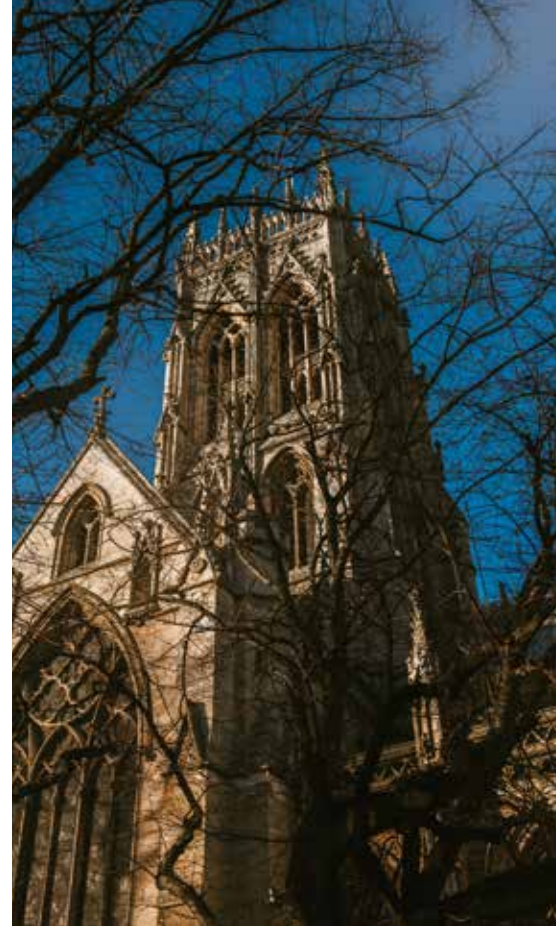
Doncaster Transport Interchange and train station offer fantastic bus and train routes covering all areas in and
