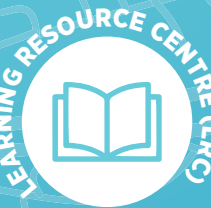
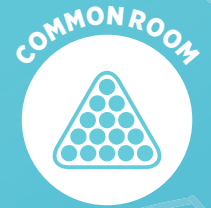
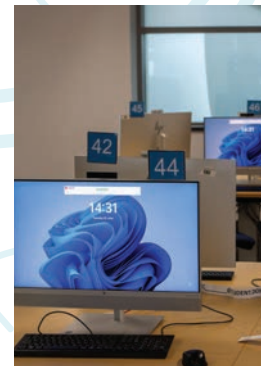

STUDENT STORY



In early February 2024, Russell Higham, manager of the Doncaster Junior Sunday Football League, briefed and tasked the year one and year two Level 3 Media Graphics students with rebranding the league to its new name of Doncaster Youth Football League.

Fifteen students submitted designs, and the committee chose Dominik Syliwoniuk's logo.

Dom's logo went live on the league's social media and website, which has over 20,000 weekly views. The league, overseeing 700 teams, will use Dom's logo on all official materials, including trophies, kits, banners, and office signage.

KICK-START YOUR SPORTING CAREER



Enhance your academic journey with our Sports Academy at Doncaster College.

Led by pros and qualified coaches, the aim of our academy is to provide you with the developmental guidance to enhance your current skills and sporting capabilities whilst gaining an academic or vocational qualification at Doncaster College.

Focusing on football or rugby (union) all of our student players receive quality coaching throughout the week and compete in the Association of Colleges (AoC) leagues throughout their academic journeys, students from all curriculum areas of the College are welcome to

come down and play.

For those students wishing to continue their studies with University Campus Doncaster, progression routes are available into our 18+ Academy squads competing in the British Universities & Colleges Sport (BUCS) leagues.

FOOTBALL ACADEMY

Our Football Academy has gone from strength to strength over the last few seasons under the guidance of new coaching staff.

Consisting of a competitive AoC men's team (16-18), a competitive AoC women's (16-18) team, and a participation team for both men and women (16+), the ethos of the football academy is to not only develop technical players on the pitch, but grow mentally strong and confident young adults off the pitch.

With aspirations for continued promotion within the AOC and BUCS leagues, the Knights Academy is led by an expert team full of professional playing experience, including Doncaster Knights First Team Assistant Coach and Head of Academy Tyson Lewis and Director of Rugby Development and Pathways Glen Kenworthy.

EMBARK ON YOUR NEXT ADVENTURE

Taking part in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) will give you skills, confidence, and something to talk about when you apply for college, university, or a job.

Beyond your academic achievements, universities want to see evidence of "soft skills" that you have developed through extra-curricular activities, such as communication, commitment, leadership, and teamwork. Your DofE Award is a fantastic way to demonstrate and evidence these skills in practice.

Since offering the DofE award in 2017 we have had over 1700 students at DN Colleges

Group take part in a DofE award, with engagement numbers rising each year.

You will complete your award within your college timetable and will be given step-by-step support from your course tutors and the DofE team.

You will have the opportunity to get involved with volunteering, activities such as benchball and dodgeball, and further develop your soft skills, preparing you for employment.

At the end of the year, you will have the opportunity to complete your camping and hiking expedition which is the area students most look forward to.

You will learn all the skills to prepare you for the expedition and receive full support completing other sections of your award from our in house DofE team. So what are you waiting for...step outside your comfort zone, meet new friends, and become a new you.

CORE SKILLS FOR YOUR FUTURE CAREER

We aim to ensure that all our students improve their confidence and competence in English and maths sufficiently enough so that they can thrive in their academic or vocational ambitions and in many aspects of their personal life. As such English and maths are an essential part of your studies here at Doncaster College.

Employers and universities really value these key qualifications, so it is important we help you achieve them. If you do not have a pass in either or both subjects, then do not worry!

As a mandatory part of your programme of study, you will work towards achieving a GCSE grade 9-4 (A*-C) with the help of our specialist tutors, alongside studying your chosen subject with us. If you have a grade 3-1 in either or both subjects, you will be enrolled onto our GCSE programme. If this is not the case, our staff will assess your current

level and you may be enrolled onto a more suitable Functional Skills Programme, which will still teach you the same skills needed for everyday life, studies, and employment.

If you have already achieved a grade 4 or above in English and Maths, you will continue to develop your skills via the embedding of English and Maths in your main curriculum lessons.

WHY STUDY ENGLISH & MATHS?

- These skills can help you understand your finances, communication, and help you gain a better understanding

of current issues (including politics and current affairs) as well as supporting you to excel on your chosen course, and then into the world of work.

- Not having these qualifications can sometimes be a real barrier for the future.
- Most employers and universities look for at least a grade 4 (C) in GCSE English and maths.
- Increase your potential earnings; people with good GCSE grades in English and maths earn approximately £2,000 more per year than those who do not.

FINDING YOUR WAY

Doncaster College is easy to get to, however you choose to travel. Our Hub Campus is based right in the heart of Doncaster city centre and we offer a free bus service to and from our partner campus at North Lindsey College in Scunthorpe.

OUR CAMPUSES

Our main campus, The Hub, is easy to reach with great transport links and within walking distance of the city's shops, cafés, and restaurants.

As well as fantastic workspaces, we have an on-site restaurant, common room, coffee bar, canteen, Learning Resource Centre (LRC), and much more!

North Lindsey College, part of DN Colleges Group, is our partner college, and is where our music provision is delivered. Located in Scunthorpe, we offer

a free bus service between The Hub and North Lindsey College each day.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

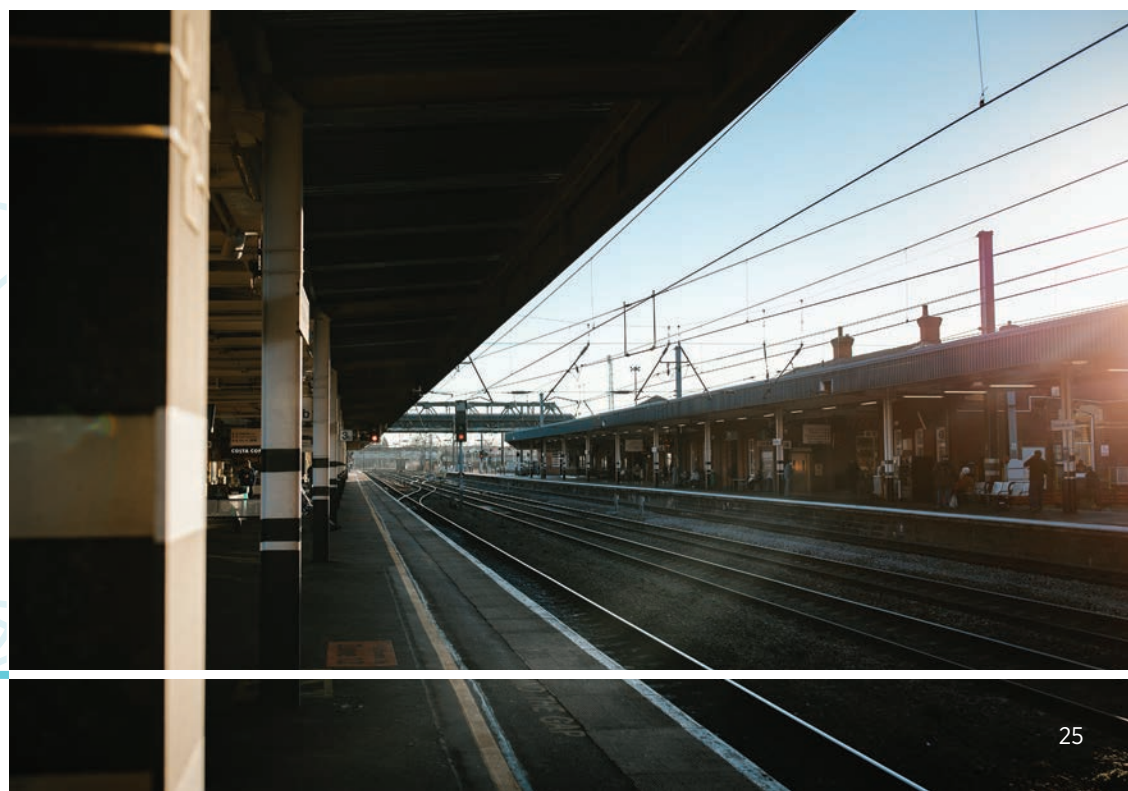
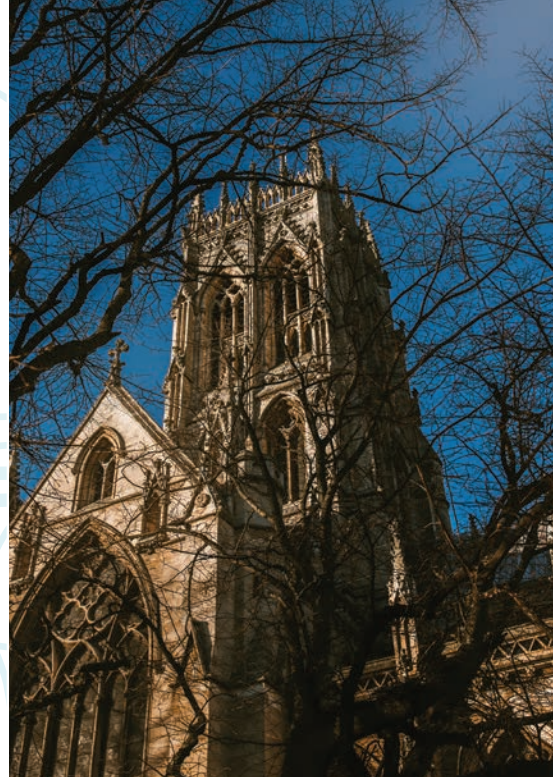

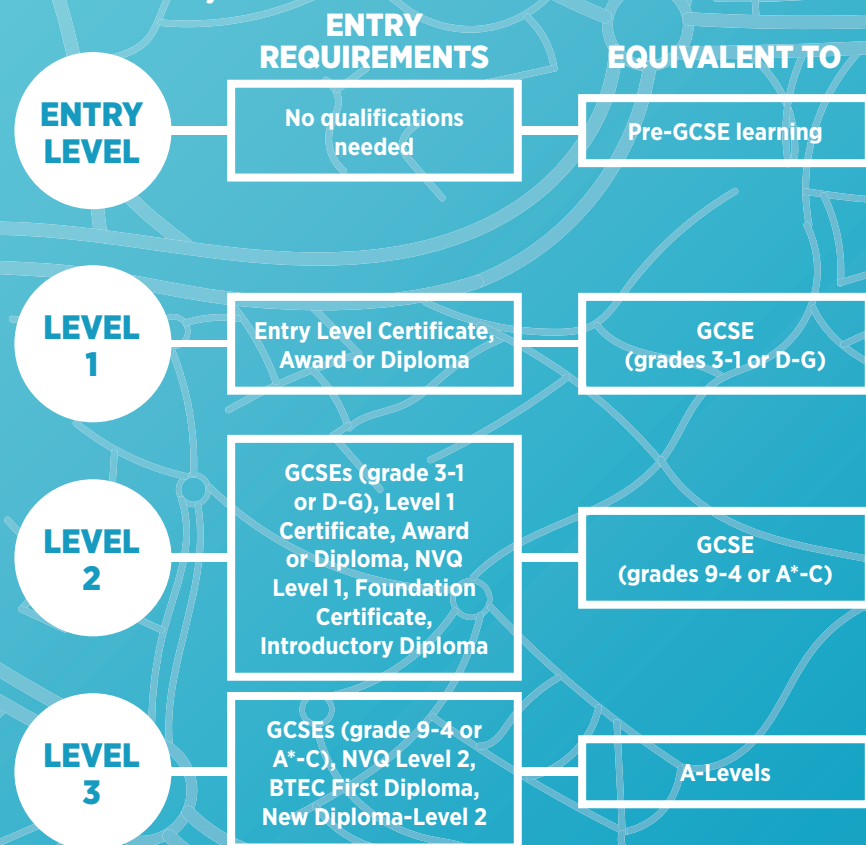
CAR PARKING

Considering applying for an A-Level but want more work experience? A T Level could be perfect for you!

T Levels are two-year courses, equivalent to three A-Levels, developed with employers to ensure the curriculum meets industry needs.

They combine classroom learning with practical experience through an industry placement lasting about 315 hours (or 45 days), giving you valuable insights and real-world exposure.

Completing a T Level equips you with the knowledge, skills, and experience needed for skilled employment, further studies, or

higher apprenticeships.

A T Level includes:

- A technical qualification, focusing on specialised skills for a specific career.
- Emphasis on digital skills, crucial in today's job market.
- An industry placement for hands-on experience.
- Maths and English standards, if not already achieved.
- Approximately 80% classroom learning and 20% industry placement, balancing theory and practise.

Each T Level ensures an industry placement

where you'll work with an employer to enhance your practical and technical skills. These placements are flexible and can be done as a continuous block, on specific days, or a mix of both. Employers can also share part of the placement with another employer if needed.

At Doncaster College, T Levels offer an exciting blend of learning and work experience, setting you on a path to success in your chosen career!

Offering a wide range of courses from brush-up literacy and numeracy skills to higher Level 3 Access to HE Diploma courses, Doncaster College's Access programme provides high quality education, personal development, and progression opportunities for all adult learners.

Increasingly, adults are returning to education in order to improve their job prospects, or to take on the challenge of a university education. Access programmes are developed to enable 'adult returnees' to build upon their past work and life experiences to increase their self-confidence, self-belief, academic,

Access to HE courses offer flexible learning options and courses can be done over one year by attending College 2 days each week, or alternatively over 2 years by attending one day per week, allowing you to choose to study around your existing commitments.

ENTRY CRITERIA

To be offered a place on our Level 3 Access to HE programmes, you will need to have GCSE grade 4/C and above in English and maths. For the Health Science Professions Diploma we can accept a science GCSE in place of maths. Although we take each individual application on its own merits and consider all qualifications

and experience, we do not routinely accept alternative qualifications such as Key Skills or Functional Skills in place of GCSE.

If you are not ready to go directly onto Access, we offer the following courses in preparation for Access; GCSE English, GCSE Maths, GCSE Biology, GCSE Chemistry, and Level 2 Access (Progression to Further Studies in Health Sciences).

Please Note: Course fees for Level 3 Access to HE apply. Students under 24 who do not already hold a level 3 qualification (e.g. A-Levels or Level 3 BTEC) do not have to pay fees. All other students can apply for the Advanced Learner Loan to cover the fees.
